Here are some of our requirements for you to free lease one or more of our equines.

- 1. The equine is always owned by LLAF, and leased to you.**
- 2. You are financially and physically responsible for the animal(s), including but not limited to: food, shelter, veterinary and farrier care, and supplies and equipment needed to give good care to the animals provided to you.**
- 3. Transporting any animal is your responsibility.**
- 4. You need to keep current health records. We will need a copy of them in our office at the end of each year the animal is leased.**
- 5. You will need to sign a lease agreement before you receive your equine(s). This is a binding legal contract.**
- 6. If you are unable to care for the equine(s) any longer, you must notify LLAF immediately so we can help make other arrangements.**
- 7. The equine(s) in your care cannot be lent, rented, leased, or otherwise provided to any other family, child, or other third party.**
- 8. We will remove any equines that are not being well taken care of, or that are being abused.**
- 9. If your equine is a young colt, he must be gelded as soon as possible; then send us the report from the vet.**
- 10. You must notify LLAF within 24 hours if a serious injury/illness/death has happened to any leased equine.**
- 11. We request pictures from time to time to update our files that show you and your family enjoying our animals. This is for informational purposes only. We will not pass on your information to anyone or any other organization. Your privacy is always protected.**
